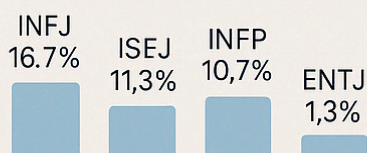
Determine the distribution of MBTI types and their association with career aspirations
