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BACKGROUND

Postpartum hemorrhage is a leading cause of maternal mordity.



OBJECTIVE

To compare outcomes among inpatients and referred cases with postpartum hemorrhage



METHOD

Cross-sectional study involving 137 women with primary postpartum hemorrhage




41.6% referred



RESULTS

Morbidity: 54.8%

- Anemia 40.1 %
- Acute respiratory distress syndrome (ARDS) 8.8 %
- Acute renal falure



Mortality:

4,4%
